Mayor Heid brought two options to the council for discussion of either installing a commercial range hood or getting an oil-less fryer for the liquor store due to the smell of grease. After discussion, motion by Wieshalla, second by Iten to purchase the Quik – n – CrispyGF5M oil-less fryer for a cost of \$7,112.50. CU
