

The monthly Browerville City Council Meeting for July met at City Hall on July 11, 2018 and was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Members Heid, Iten, Wieshalla, Fenner and Santer were present. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Consent Agenda:

Department Reports:

Liquor Store: Angie Benning was present to update the Council. The City received a quote for new vinyl plank flooring and the replacement of the beer tower. Benning will get additional quotes for flooring.

Public Works: Kent Louwagie of Bolton & Menk was present with an update on the 2018 Project and to present a partial payment request from RL Larson in the amount of \$217,491.59. motion by Fenner, second by Wieshalla to approve the payment. CU

Ambulance: Bob Toews was present to provide the Council with information regarding the purchase of a new ambulance. The current ambulance is a 2012 model. Toews provided the information that the City could purchase a new 2017 Horton Ambulance and new cot from Premier Specialty Vehicles through the SAVVIK Purchasing Group for a final cost of \$158,545.00. motion by Wieshalla, second by Santer to approve the purchase. Law Enforcement: Council discussed continuing problems with jake braking, noisy acceleration, go-carts on streets. It was felt that additional reporting may help explain what the Sheriff's Dept. is doing for the City.

City Lot Purchase – Dan's Prize – City Council heard that Dan's Prize is interested in purchasing the City's lot located south of Lakewood Clinic. Motion by Wieshalla, second by Santer to set conditions of sale as: payment in full of existing assessment against the lot and Buyer pays all costs associated with the purchase/sale. CU
